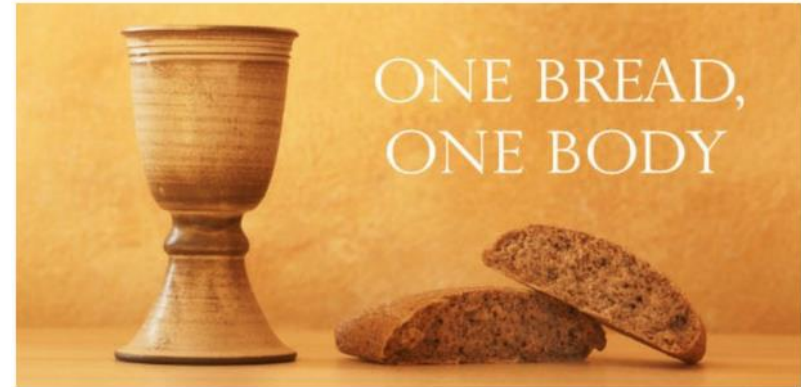
Operation Christmas Child- Shoeboxes with packing instructions are available in the Narthex.
